



Homebrewed - Terms of Agreement on Google Platforms

These Terms of Agreement (also referred to as “Terms of Use”) govern your use of the Homebrewed Android application. Homebrewed is a software product of baseworks.tech.

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Section 1: Company identity and contact details

Homebrewed is provided by baseworks.tech, registered in the Netherlands under Chamber of Commerce number (KvK) 98170643, VAT number NL005312934B1, with postal address Box E1586, Oder 20, 2491 DC Den Haag, Netherlands. In these terms, “baseworks.tech,” “we,” “us” and “our” refer to that provider.

Section 2: Scope and acceptance

These terms apply only to the Homebrewed Android application with application ID app.homebrewed, including a build distributed through Google Play.

They do not govern the baseworks.tech website, online shop, other baseworks.tech software, the Homebrewed iOS application or any Docker/self-hosted version of Homebrewed.

By downloading, installing or using Homebrewed, you agree to these terms. If you do not agree, do not use the app and remove it from your device.

If you use Homebrewed for or on behalf of another person, household or organization, you confirm that you are authorized to do so and remain responsible for your own use.

Nothing in these terms excludes, restricts or makes conditional a right or remedy that applicable law does not allow us to exclude or restrict. Consumers retain all mandatory protections of the law that applies to them.

Section 3: Google Play terms and application licence

When you obtain Homebrewed through Google Play, your use of Google Play is separately governed by the [Google Play Terms of Service](#) and other applicable Google terms. Those terms concern Google's store and services. These Homebrewed Terms of Use are an end-user agreement between you and baseworks.tech for the app itself.

Subject to these terms, applicable Google Play rules and your compliance with them, baseworks.tech grants you a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable and revocable licence to install and use Homebrewed for personal or internal household purposes on compatible Android devices that you own or control, or that you are otherwise authorized to use.



The app is licensed, not sold. No ownership in Homebrewed or its proprietary components is transferred to you. Independent open-source, font, icon and data licences continue to govern the corresponding materials and are not restricted by this licence.

Google is not the provider of Homebrewed and does not assume baseworks.tech's obligations concerning the app, its content, maintenance or support except where Google's own terms or applicable law expressly provide otherwise.

If Homebrewed is installed from an authorized source other than Google Play, references in these terms to Google Play apply only to Google Play's involvement and not to that installation source.

Section 4: Trial, purchase and restoration

Homebrewed is free to download. An app-managed free trial starts automatically when Homebrewed is first launched. The trial lasts for 7 days: seven consecutive periods of 24 hours. No Google Play purchase or payment method is required to start the trial.

The trial does not convert automatically into a paid purchase. Homebrewed does not charge a subscription and does not make an automatic charge when the trial ends.

When the trial ends, adding and editing stop. You can continue to browse meals, recipes, ingredients and products already stored in the app, export a complete backup, and continue household synchronization. To add or edit again, you must deliberately buy the permanent unlock through Google Play.

The permanent unlock is the non-consumable Google Play one-time product `app.homebrewed.full`. It permanently enables adding and editing for the purchasing Google Account, subject to Google Play's rules and any later refund, revocation or invalidation. It is not a subscription and has no recurring charge.

At the publication date of these terms, the intended euro base price is €9.99. Google Play may display a localized regional price, currency and applicable tax treatment. The price and currency displayed in the Google Play purchase interface immediately before confirmation are authoritative for that transaction.

Google handles payment authorization, payment credentials, billing, transaction records and refund requests under Google's terms and applicable law. baseworks.tech does not receive your payment-card credentials, billing address or Google Account credentials.

Homebrewed queries Google Play for the current ownership state of the permanent unlock. A purchase that is pending, cancelled or cannot be verified does not unlock paid functionality. A successfully verified purchase is acknowledged through Google Play.

A temporary Google Play, network or billing-service failure does not pause or extend a trial. A trial continues to run and expires at its normal time while the store is unavailable. After expiry, the app remains read-only for affected adding and editing functions until Google Play becomes available for purchase or restoration. Browsing, backup export and household synchronization remain available.



A previously verified permanent unlock may remain available from a sanitized local entitlement record during a temporary store failure. If a later successful Google Play ownership query reports that the purchase is no longer owned, including following a refund or revocation, the permanent unlock is removed.

The app provides a Restore control. Restoration depends on Google Play recognizing the purchase for the Google Account and storefront currently available on the device.

Section 5: What Homebrewed provides

Homebrewed is an on-device tool for recording meals, maintaining a personal food and recipe catalogue, organizing household food information, setting nutrition goals and comparing nutritional characteristics. It can obtain product information from Open Food Facts and can synchronize local information directly between devices in a deliberately paired household.

The app is designed to operate without a Homebrewed account or baseworks.tech cloud service. The features available in a particular version are those described in the app and its current Google Play listing.

Screenshots, examples and explanatory text illustrate intended use but are not guarantees that every item of third-party food data will be present or correct.

Section 6: Wellness and nutrition limitations

Homebrewed is a general-wellness and food-journaling tool. It is not a medical device and is not intended to diagnose, prevent, monitor, predict, prognose, treat or alleviate a disease, injury or disability. It does not measure blood glucose, insulin or your body's response to food.

Glycemic index, food insulin index, glycemic load, insulin load and other calculated or displayed values are estimates based on available data and general models. They are not measurements of your personal response and may be incomplete, inaccurate or unsuitable for your circumstances.

Do not use Homebrewed to calculate medication or insulin doses or as a substitute for professional medical advice, diagnosis, treatment, monitoring or emergency assistance. If you manage a health condition, follow your clinician's guidance and your own appropriate measurements, and consult a qualified professional before changing treatment, medication or diet.

Ingredient, allergen and nutrition information can be missing, outdated or wrong, including data obtained from Open Food Facts or entered by a household member. Always check the current product label and obtain appropriate professional advice for allergies, intolerances and other safety decisions.

Section 7: Your content, device and backups

You retain whatever rights you hold in information and images you enter or import into Homebrewed.



Because the app has no baseworks.tech account or server, you do not grant baseworks.tech a licence to host that content merely by storing it in the app.

You are responsible for:

- having the right to enter, import, use and share the information and images you place in the app;
- keeping your device, screen lock, Google Account and exported archives secure;
- reviewing and controlling Android, Google or device-manufacturer backup settings that can copy eligible app data or transfer it to another device;
- maintaining an independent export where you need one before deleting the app, resetting data, importing an archive or changing devices; and
- checking important information against an authoritative source before relying on it.

Deleting the app, resetting its data, losing the device or importing a replacement archive can remove or overwrite information. A system backup is not guaranteed to include every Homebrewed file or to restore successfully. baseworks.tech has no server copy and cannot recover your data for you.

Section 8: Household sharing

Household sharing synchronizes information directly between deliberately paired devices. Every member of the household can see and edit the information shared within it. Join or invite only people whom you intend to give that access.

You are responsible for obtaining any permission needed before adding another person's information or image to a household. Do not use household sharing to disclose information unlawfully or without authority.

Leaving a household stops future synchronization with that household but does not erase information already copied to another member's device. baseworks.tech cannot inspect, control or remotely erase those copies.

Synchronization can be delayed, interrupted or unavailable because of Bluetooth state, Nearby devices or legacy location permissions, device compatibility, Android or manufacturer behaviour, distance, power management or conflicting edits.

Review important entries after synchronization and keep an independent export where loss would matter.

Section 9: Open Food Facts, Google ML Kit and external resources

Homebrewed can query and display information from [Open Food Facts](#), an independent collaborative database. Open Food Facts is not operated or controlled by baseworks.tech. Its availability, data, images and services are governed by its own terms, privacy practices and licences.



Community-supplied product information may be inaccurate, incomplete or outdated. baseworks.tech does not independently verify every Open Food Facts result and does not guarantee its accuracy or fitness for a particular purpose.

The Android app uses Google ML Kit to recognize barcodes and QR codes on the device. Use of ML Kit is subject to Google's applicable terms. Google controls the availability, maintenance and operation of its SDK and any metrics processing described in the Homebrewed - Privacy and Data Protection Policy on Google platforms. baseworks.tech does not guarantee that scanning will work with every code, camera, device or Android version.

The app and its documentation may link to other independent websites or research sources. A link is provided for reference and does not mean that baseworks.tech controls, endorses or guarantees the external service or its current content.

Section 10: Permissions and acceptable use

Homebrewed requests Android permissions only for app features that need them. Camera access supports barcode and household QR-code scanning. Nearby device's permissions support Bluetooth household discovery, connection and advertising. On Android 11 and earlier, Android requires legacy location permission for Bluetooth discovery even though Homebrewed does not use Bluetooth to determine your location. Internet access supports Open Food Facts requests and ordinary linked resources.

You must not use Homebrewed to:

- violate applicable law or another person's rights, privacy or confidentiality;
- store or share content that you do not have the right to use;
- bypass security protections, tamper with household authentication or gain unauthorized access to another device;
- introduce malicious code, interfere with the app's operation or misuse external services reached through the app;
- misrepresent Homebrewed output as a medical measurement, diagnosis or professional instruction; or
- reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the proprietary parts of the app except to the extent that applicable law or an applicable open-source licence expressly permits it.

This section does not prohibit activity protected by mandatory law, including lawful security research or reverse engineering necessary to achieve interoperability where those rights cannot be waived.

Section 11: Intellectual property and third-party software

Homebrewed's proprietary software, design, documentation, branding and original content are owned by baseworks.tech or its licensors. No ownership right is transferred to you. Rights not expressly granted by these terms or mandatory law are reserved.

Homebrewed includes independently developed software, fonts, icons and open data governed by their own licences or terms. Those licences continue to apply to the corresponding material and prevail over these terms where they grant rights that these terms do not. The current notices are identified in the Homebrewed - Licenses and Acknowledgements on Google Platforms document available on the [baseworks.tech policies page](https://baseworks.tech/policies).

“Homebrewed,” “baseworks.tech,” “Android,” “Google Play,” “Google,” “Open Food Facts” and other third-party names and marks identify their respective products, services or owners. Their use does not imply endorsement or sponsorship.

Section 12: Updates, availability and support

We may provide bug fixes, security changes, compatibility changes and feature updates through Google Play. If enabled in your Google Play settings, Google Play may install updates automatically. Updates may change or remove functionality where reasonably necessary for security, legal compliance, platform compatibility, service availability or product development. Some updates may require a supported Android version, Google Play services version or device capability.

Providing the download, trial, or retained read-only features without charge is not a promise that every feature or external service will remain unchanged or available forever. The permanent adding and editing unlock described in Section 4 remains subject to the purchase terms stated there. It does not include a guaranteed support period, service-level agreement, cloud service or future feature set. Mandatory obligations to provide conformity or security updates remain unaffected.

We may stop offering new downloads or updates where continued distribution becomes unlawful, unsafe, technically impracticable or commercially discontinued. This does not remove remedies that applicable consumer law provides.

Reasonable support for Homebrewed is available at support@baseworks.tech. Unless mandatory law or a separate written agreement requires otherwise, no response time, resolution time or continuous availability level is promised.

Section 13: Warranties and liability

Homebrewed is supplied subject to warranties and remedies that cannot lawfully be excluded, including applicable consumer conformity rights.



To the maximum extent permitted by law, Homebrewed and its third-party information are provided “as is” and “as available.” We do not warrant that the app will be uninterrupted, error-free or compatible with every device, Google Play services configuration or future Android version, or that food, nutrition, calculation, synchronization or external-service information will always be complete or accurate.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, baseworks.tech is not liable for indirect, incidental, special or consequential loss, or for loss arising solely from inaccurate user-entered or third-party food information, failure to maintain a backup, unauthorized household access, or use of the app contrary to Section 6.

Nothing in these terms excludes or limits liability for fraud, wilful misconduct, death or personal injury caused by negligence, breach of a mandatory consumer obligation, or any other liability that cannot legally be excluded or limited. Any limitation is reduced to the minimum extent necessary to comply with applicable law.

Google and other third-party service providers remain responsible only to the extent provided by their own terms or applicable law.

Section 14: Privacy

The Homebrewed - Privacy and Data Protection Policy on Google platforms explains how the Android application handles information, including local storage, trial timing, cached entitlement and product metadata, Google Play Billing queries, Open Food Facts requests, Google ML Kit metrics, permissions, household sharing, Android backup, exports and deletion. The Google Play Data safety section is a separate summary prepared for the released app and does not replace the full Privacy Policy.

Section 15: Suspension and termination

You may stop using Homebrewed at any time and remove it from your device. Removing the app does not necessarily remove system backups, exported files or household copies held elsewhere; use the relevant Android, Google, recipient or household controls for those copies.

Your licence rights under these terms end if you materially breach these terms and do not remedy the breach where applicable law requires an opportunity to do so. Google may separately suspend access to Google Play or an application under Google's terms. Homebrewed's local-only design does not provide baseworks.tech with a general remote account-suspension mechanism.

Sections concerning intellectual property, third-party licences, warranty limitations, liability, governing law and accrued rights continue to apply after use ends where their nature requires it.

Section 16: Changes to these terms

We may publish revised terms for future versions or future use of Homebrewed. Each version will show its published date, effective date and version number on the [baseworks.tech policies page](https://baseworks.tech/policies/page).

Where a change materially affects existing users, we will provide an appropriate notice through the app, its Google Play release notes or another reasonable channel before the change takes effect where required. A later version does not retrospectively remove a right or remedy that has already arisen under mandatory law.

Section 17: Governing law and disputes

These terms and the relationship between you and baseworks.tech are governed by Dutch law.

If you are a consumer, you also retain the protection of mandatory law in the country where you habitually reside when that law applies. You may bring proceedings in any court made available by mandatory jurisdiction rules.

Before starting formal proceedings, please contact support@baseworks.tech with a clear description of the issue so that we can try to resolve it. This request does not prevent you from using a court, regulator, alternative dispute-resolution procedure or other remedy available under applicable law, and it does not shorten a legal limitation period.

Google is not a party to disputes between you and baseworks.tech concerning Homebrewed merely because the app was obtained through Google Play.

Section 18: General provisions

If a provision of these terms is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions continue in effect. The affected provision will apply to the maximum extent permitted by law or, where necessary, be replaced by a valid provision that most closely reflects its purpose.

A delay or failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. A waiver is effective only for the specific instance for which it is given.

You may not transfer your rights or obligations under these terms except where mandatory law permits. We may transfer our rights and obligations as part of a lawful reorganization, sale or transfer of Homebrewed, provided that consumer rights are not reduced contrary to applicable law.

These terms, the Homebrewed - Privacy and Data Protection Policy on Google platforms, the applicable third-party licences and any mandatory Google Play terms form the relevant agreement for your use of the Android app. They do not create an employment, partnership, agency or joint-venture relationship.

Section 19: Governing language

The authoritative version of these terms is English. A translation may be supplied for convenience. If a translation differs from the English version, the English version prevails to the extent permitted by applicable law. Mandatory language requirements remain unaffected.
